

Free Career Building Program for Young Adults Interested in Creating a Bright Future!

The Westchester-Putnam Workforce Development Board (WPWDB) has funded a career building program for young adults between the ages of 18-24 who are out of school and live in Mount Vernon, NY to provide educational and employment services. The program will provide resources and services to help participants explore career opportunities, achieve a high school equivalency diploma, enroll in higher education, and obtain long-term employment that leads to a career, not just a job. The program runs to June 30, 2022.

The program includes:

- Placement services for both jobs and registered apprenticeship programs
- Comprehensive and customized occupational training
- Pre-apprenticeship programs for entrance into apprenticeship training for a specified trade
- Aptitude and skill assessment tests to identify skills and education gaps

The program is provided free of charge through three contracted youth agencies listed.
