- Demand for clean energy and semiconductor jobs
- Focus on upskilling and education for emerging sectors Plans to address workforce preparation for high-growth fields were discussed. Michele Green emphasized continued efforts with ACCES-VR and the reentry population.

#### C. WPWDB Committee Restructuring

Existing committees include Performance & Accountability, Program, Executive, and Business. Proposed additions: Youth and Emerging Sectors. Virtual meetings for committees and hybrid format for board meetings were recommended.
